

Title II Report

Section 207 of Title II of the Higher Education Act mandates that the Department of Education collect data on the state assessments, other requirements, and standards for teacher certification and licensure, as well as data on the performance of teacher preparation programs. The law requires the Secretary to use the data in submitting an annual report on the quality of teacher preparation in the Congress.
